

The admiration and interest in amber originated in ancient world. Ancient people used the stone as amulets and jewelry. Later, the golden miracle began to compose poetry tradition. Ancient legends about amber hide the secrets of the origin of the stone.

One legend tells the following.

Long before the appearance of man on earth, there were two celestial bodies. Eventually, it became close stars at the same sky, and one of them is dropped to the ground. Hitting the rocks at the bottom of the sea the sun crumbled into small pieces. Since then the waves bring to the shore particles amber sun.

There are several varieties of amber differing in transparency and shades. This diversity is dependent mainly on the temperature and humidity which affect an amber resin. In ancient times the value of amber is determined by its color. There was even a so-called "royal amber." In the East valued yellow stones with a green tint or pale, as if from milk. In the world can be found about 350 colors of amber from white to green. This stone can be quite compare with the sun - so beautifully played by the sun shimmering on its surface.

This stone is generally found in association with lignite coal, which is also the fossilized remains of trees and other plant material. Amber is considered a gemstone and it has been always highly prized for its warmth and beauty. Amber has different poetic names - "tears of the sea", "gift of the sun", and has become a symbol of health and happiness.

The most fantastically beautiful use of amber in history was the creation of "the amber room" in Catherine Palace (Russia). Imagine if you can an entire room decorated with panels of cut amber, gold, Venetian mirrors, Florentine mosaics worked in amber, wood and mother-of-pearl inlay floors - all of it lit by candlelight. It was described as the "eighth wonder of the world".

Amber color (from yellow to milky white), probably caused and continues to cause people to associate with gold. Already in the times of the ancient civilizations of amber has earned a reputation as a kind of "currency" - he prized so dearly. In the Middle Ages monopoly on amber extraction passed from one country to another, which indicated that its extraordinary popularity.




Amber tile Big buckwheat






AT2 Amber tile Egg yolk






AT6 Amber tile Fire crack



Technical specifications:

Material is fragile. It is forbidden to throw, shake. Maintenance and transport at temperatures in the range of 1-100 degrees Celsius, without temperature fluctuation. When freezing tile cracks.



Application:


Walls, ceilings, floors, countertops, bar tops, SPA salons, hammam, etc.





Installation:

Installation is similar to both the marble slabs, onyx, mosaics with epoxy adhesive, etc. On mounting adhesive (liquid nails white or transparent color) is applied to the prepared surface. Cutting can be a diamond disc thickness of 0.8 mm on the machine for cutting tiles with a water-cooled.



Installation:

Basically, the entire disclosure of beauty products is used with the backlight reverse side of the tile. For this purpose mounted design of the light panel, which is fixed with a transparent plate assembly glue.






Installation:

In the case of mounting the tiles on the floor, tabletops, bar - plate should be closed with tempered glass. If there is a desire not to close the tiles with a tempered glass, in this case, tiles should be laid as mosaics (tiles size 50x50x20 mm). Attention! Walk on the mosaic uncoated by glass only barefoot.

Surface mounting the tiles must be insulated to prevent freezing tiles.




Care:

This type of tile, as well as slabs of natural stone must be polished every two months. As amber is an electrostatic stone, it collects a dust. In this regard, the surface of the stone need of treatment or environmentally friendly detergents, or by polishing.



Care:

Organic material is oxidized and eventually, covered with a thin layer of amber acid. In this case, the color becomes darker (popularly referred to as the effect antique). But with regular polishing it is not noticeable.




In medicine:

Amber acid is a natural substance and is present in all organisms. According to studies, the substance stimulates the production of energy in cells, enhances cellular respiration and neutralizes free radicals.
